- i. Packing of dangerous goods, [including those that supervise the packing of Cargo Transport Units];
- ii. Marking, labelling or placarding of dangerous goods; and
- iii. Preparing and signing transport documentation [shipper and container packing declarations].

CONDITIONS:

- 1 This acceptance only relates to the online version and requires **the pass mark of 80% to be achieved.**
2. This certificate is issued in respect of the 2018 edition of the IMDG code – which will be in effect until 31 December 2021. After that date the certificate must be endorsed by AMSA for the subsequent edition of the IMDG Code.
3. When the course material is updated for the next edition of the IMDG code, an AMSA

assessment and verification audit of the updated course material will be required. AMSA will endorse the certificate for the relevant edition of the IMDG Code when satisfied the course material meets the requirements of the updated Code.

4. Where the specified package is employed to comply with the training requirements of Chapter 1.3 of the IMDG Code, the trainer is to ensure that every student has available a copy of the IMDG code mentioned in either condition 2, or in a completed AMSA endorsement, that is in either voluntary or mandatory effect. There is to be evidence that this has been complied with and this is to be available for audit to a surveyor upon request.
5. The certificate number of this acceptance certificate is to be included on all training records issued in relation to it where the training is to be relied upon by shore based personnel engaged in the transport of dangerous goods intended to be shipped by sea from Australia
7. A copy of this acceptance certificate is to be provided to users of the training course upon request.

Subject to the conditions this acceptance certificate shall remain valid for **AlertForce Pty Ltd** until the **31st of December 2027**, unless it is withdrawn or altered for any reason before that date.
