CPCCE3014A Remove non-friable asbestos

COURSE OVERVIEW:

This course is for individuals who may need to remove non-friable asbestos in the course of their work. It is designed for existing workers who have experience in the construction industry and hold the White Card.

Upon successful completion of this course you may perform asbestos removal or related work for enterprises that hold a Class A or B Asbestos Removal (or Assessor licence for CPCCE3014A). To obtain your own asbestos removal licence you need to complete relevant qualifications Class B and/Class A plus at least one Supervisor per application. For removal and assessor licences you should make further enquiries through the relevant state/territory WHS or OHS authority.

QUALIFICATION:

A Statement of Attainment is issued on successful completion.

PRE-REQUISITES:

Hold White Card. Will be over 18 years of age and are expected to be able to speak and read English to a sufficient standard to complete the course.

Participants must also be over 18 years of age and hold the unit of competency CPCCD3014A Remove non-friable asbestos at a minimum, together with experience of performing asbestos removal.

QUALIFICATION:

A Statement of Attainment is issued on successful completion.

PRE-REQUISITES:

Hold white card. Will be over 18 years of age and are expected to be able to speak and read English to a sufficient standard to complete the course.

- » Understand and implement the correct safety requirements for a variety of asbestos removal projects including understanding air monitoring procedures/results
- » Implement and direct emergency procedures when dealing with incidents
- » Identify different asbestos materials, interpret and communicate the contents of registers, develop asbestos removal control plans and to coordinate equipment personnel for an effective & compliant removal.

CPCBC5014A Conduct Asbestos Assessment Associated with Removal

COURSE OVERVIEW:

Such monitoring and testing is an integral part of identifying hazards, assessing risks, monitoring the effectiveness of controls, and ensuring that the workplace is free of asbestos fibres prior to reoccupation.
